Bí Cineálta!

We want everyone at our school to feel safe and happy.
If you think that you are being bullied or someone else is being bullied, you need to tell a teacher, another adult that you trust, or a student council representative.
They will know what to do to help!

Get help!

Tell someone!

If a pupil tells a staff member that they are being bullied, we will:

- > listen carefully to the pupil
- > ask the pupil what they want to happen
- > work together to create a plan
- > talk to their parents/guardians
- > talk to the other pupil(s) involved
- > talk with the other pupils' parents/guardians

Bullying can also happen online through messages, games, or social media. Even if it only happens once, it is cyberbullying.

Our school has a Bí Cineálta Policy to try to stop bullying behaviour. We look at this policy every year to see what is working well or what could work better.

We will ask you what you think.

Bullying is when someone repeatedly hurts you with words, actions, or by making you feel left out or upset.

It's not just a one-time thing—it happens more than once and can make you feel unsafe or unhappy.
