### Tier 2: At-Risk for Chronic Absenteeism

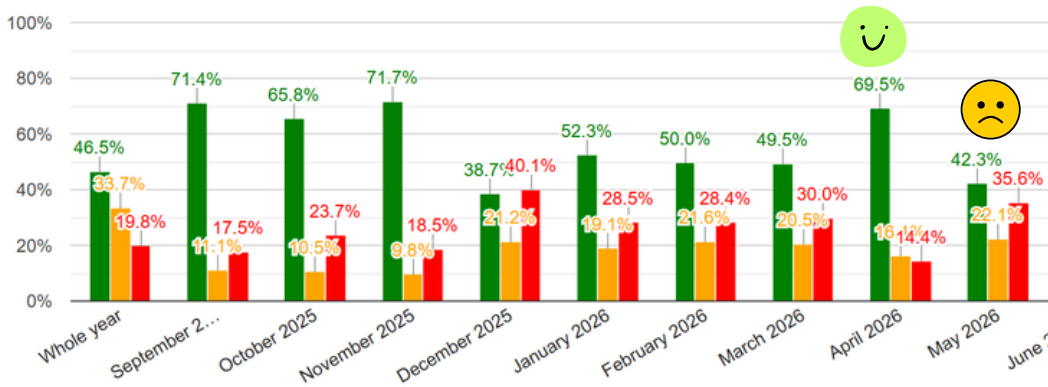
Attending: less than 95% but 90% or more of the time
